## **Drama Grades Classes**

- 4. Students should arrive to class on time and are the responsibility of the school during class time only. Students must not use their mobile phone during class time. Should you need to use your phone to contact a parent or guardian you must inform your teacher first.
- 6. Parents should contact the school if a student will be absent from class. Attendance is very important particularly when approaching exam time.
